



POST TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

After The Heat Treatment

1. **Wash the hair In 20 minutes** - We recommend using dawn dishwashing liquid or something comparable and allow to sit in the hair for a few minutes. Do not wash out in a bath. Itching may occur if the oil is on the hair for too long.
2. **IMPORTANT!** - You must perform another comb out within 48 hours to remove any dead lice and eggs. If you find a louse moving lice after the heat treatment, not to worry, they are badly injured and will die soon.
3. **Follow up combing** – Comb again 10 days later for live lice. If you come across a live louse call us and we will help you.

Head Lice Comb-out

Comb wet or dry

1. Part hair into squares.
 2. Place the lice comb in the part of the hair and flat on the scalp slightly tilted upward.
 3. Push the comb into the hair as far as possible. When running the comb through, and it becomes hard to continue, stop, reset the comb, and don't push the comb as far in the hair as before.
- ❖ *Do not allow the hair to withdraw more than halfway out of the comb teeth-this will hinder removal.*
 - ❖ *Keep the comb on the scalp and follow the shape of the head without lifting the comb, gently scrape the scalp.*
4. After pulling the lice comb through to the ends of the hair, move the comb over the top of a bowl and strum the teeth of the comb to dislodge eggs and lice. If combing wet hair, use a slightly moist towel to wipe the comb. Be careful not to fling them onto yourself.
 5. Repeat combing down and then sideways in the same section until no more lice or eggs are found.
 6. Repeat this process around the entire head.
