

## POST TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wash the hair In 20 minutes Use a good shampoo and rinse in shower, kitchen or other. Not in the bath! leaving the oil in the hair longer than 20 minutes is okay. The oil is non-toxic, but Itching may occur if the oil is on the hair for hours at a time. IMPORTANT! You must perform another comb-out immediately after the rinse to remove any dead lice and eggs while taking advantage of the residue left behind for a smooth combout. Use the instructions below to comb-out.
- 2. If you wish to have your treatment guaranteed, please discuss with the Technician.

## **Head Lice Comb-out** Comb wet or dry

- 1. Part hair into squares.
- 2. Place the lice comb in the part of the hair and flat on the scalp.
- 3. Push the comb into the hair as far as possible. When running the comb through, and it becomes hard to continue, stop, reset the comb, and don't push the comb as far in the hair as before.
- Do not allow the hair to withdraw more than halfway out of the comb teeth-this will hinder removal.
- Keep the comb on the scalp and follow the shape of the head without lifting the comb, gently scrape the scalp.
- 4. After pulling the lice comb through to the ends of the hair, move the comb over the top of a bowl and strum the teeth of the comb to dislodge eggs and lice. If combing wet hair, strum the comb in a bowl of water or use a slightly moist towel to wipe the comb.
- 5. Repeat combing down and then sideways in the same section until no more lice or eggs are found.
- 6. Repeat this process around the entire head.

## **IMPORTANT!**

## **HOUSE CLEANING**

Please follow immediately after treatment. We want to be sure you have a great start when it comes to your home. No need to go crazy and clean everything. Follow our directions and thats it!

- 1. **Immediately** sweep or vacuum the area where the treatment has taken place.
- 2. Wash All items that have been used in the last 3 days, clothes, linens, towels, coats, scarfs, etc. in hot water or in a dryer set on hot. If you do not want to wash in hot water, you may set aside for 2 days and then wash and dry as usual.
- 3. **Furniture**-Vacuum all furniture, <u>do not use pesticide sprays</u>! Wipe down hard surfaces. Small throw pillows and other fabric non-wearable items may be placed in the dryer on high if possible.
- 4. **Hairbrushes and accessories** Remove hair from all items before placing on the top rack of the dishwasher or soak in hot water, not boiling.
- 5. **Toys and Stuffed Animals** All fabric items that cannot fit into the dryer can be vacuumed. Wipe or vacuum hard toys and set aside for 2 days.
- 6. **Automobiles** Vacuum the carpets and seats if they are fabric. Wipe down if the seats are leather. Remove the lining material of a child car seat if possible and wash or vacuum.
